



Snack Break	8.45 am – 9 am (1D, 1E & 1W) 11.45 am – 12 pm (1C, 1P, 1R & 1I)
Dismissal Time (Staggered)	12.50 pm (1C & 1P) 1.00 pm (1R & 1I) 1.10 pm (1D, 1E & 1W)

Class confirmation letter will be sent via PG and the letter will be used as entry pass to the school for 2 adults.

What is it like in Primary School?

Start of first Day (2 Jan 2026)

- Enter the school via gate 3.
- Take your child to the classroom.
- Proceed to the hall for engagement session.
- Proceed to canteen / Leave the school via gate 1.
- Park your car at the HDB car park if you are driving to school.

Start of the Day (5 Jan 2026 onwards)



- Take your child to Gate 3.
- If you are driving to school, enter the school compound via Gate 2 (drive in) to drop your child off at the designated car porch. To avoid congestion, please drive off quickly after your child/ward has alighted.
- Or park at HDB carpark and walk to Gate 3.

Dismissal of Students

- All students will be dismissed at Gate 3 unless they are taking the school bus or going to Student Care.
- Please indicate clearly in the dismissal arrangement form and Identification Card if your child is taking the school bus, going to Student Care or going home by Gate 3.








What is it like in Primary School?
